

Principles for handling the data collected by Nitomani School.

Legal grounds for collecting information?

We gather information about our users based on the permission they have given in advance.

Why do we collect information?

Primarily we collect information to store the users' learning material. Secondly, we collect information about the users for reasons related to site management.

Information is also collected for the purpose of improving the site's user friendliness and functions.

What information do we collect?

The collected information includes registration date, gender, first and last names, birth date, e-mail address, username, and the data on the learning material the user has completed.

From where do we collect information?

We collect information that you give when you register to our site, give feedback, perform studies, discuss on the forum, log in, and when you log out. Moreover, we automatically receive and store data about your PC and browser, including the IP-address, software and hardware details and the web page you have requested.

For what do we use the information?

On top of the information being used in parallel with the forum, the information collected from you can be used to personalize your experience and fulfilling your individual needs, offering adjusted advertising, developing our website, developing our customer service and ways of supporting you, e-mail contacting, and managing a contest, campaign or questionnaire.

Do we give away information?

We will not sell, trade or otherwise transfer information that could be used to identify you to outside parties. This does not include trusted third parties that help us maintain our website and managing business, but these parties are also obliged to keep the information confidential as has been ruled in the personal information law (523/1999).

We believe that sharing information is necessary, when the intention is to investigate, prevent or otherwise handle illegal activity, suspicions of fraud, situations where a person might be under physical threat, the breaking of our user agreement, as well as other matters required by law.

Non-private information however can be given to other parties for marketing, advertising or other use.

Do we use cookies?

Yes. Our cookies aid the usability of our website and recognizing returning site users. More so, cookies improve the user's experience by following and offering content that may interest the user. This use of cookies is however not affiliated with information that may identify our website.

Transferring information outside the EU and EEA.

Nitomani user registry will not give information to outside the EU and EEA area.

Principles of protecting the registry.

The data physically resides in the northern European Azure servers in monitored server rooms, which can only be accessed by their employees. The information is also protected against network break-ins.

We alone own the information collected on this site. Information that could be used to identify you will not be sold, traded, transferred or given to any other company for any reason without your permission, excluding executing a transaction or an event, like delivering an order or the information required to fix an error.

The data is physically located on the northern European Azure servers in monitored server rooms, where access is limited to employees. The information is also protected against network break-ins.

Transferring information by user's request

The user has a right to receive their personal information stored in the registry in an ordered and usable form, to be transferred into another service. The request can be sent via the contact information shown below.

The right to inspect your personal information in the registry.

You can inspect your information in the registry by sending us a request. The request can be sent via the contact information shown below.

The right to demand correcting your information in the registry.

You can demand us to correct your information in the registry by sending us a note of what information and how they should be corrected. Correcting some information may require proof of accuracy, such as personal information. The request to correct information can be done via the contact information shown below.

The right to delete your own information

You can ask us to delete your own information from the registry by sending us a note. Deleting the information leads to losing the usage rights of the service. The request to delete the information can be done via the contact information shown below.

Permission

We ask from everyone in the registry during the registration process the permission to save their information and using the information for example to market our services.
